Thornbury High STEAMing Ahead

Students at Thornbury High will be learning at the cutting edge of science, technology, engineering, arts and maths thanks to \$14.9 million in funding to build modern classrooms and a brand new STEAM Centre.

The funding is the culmination of a huge joint effort with parents, staff, students and the THS Redevelopment Group who worked alongside me to get this across the line within Government.

Making the most of Victoria's BIG BUILD OPPORTUNITY

The BIG BUILD being undertaken by the Andrews Government is not just about infrastructure – it's about creating opportunity.

We are building better transport networks, more homes, better healthcare and making Victoria a renewable energy powerhouse.

Here are just some of the ways our community will benefit.



We're transforming how we move around with the Metro Tunnel, Airport Rail, Suburban Rail Link, North-East Link and removing 75 Level Crossings - including 4 in Preston.



\$6 billion will build 12,000 new social and affordable homes to support vulnerable Victorians, help more first home buyers and create 10,000 jobs every year over four years.



We're ramping up our wind and solar capacity, boosting energy efficiency in homes, changing how we recycle and making big investments in community-owned renewable projects.



A huge funding boost will go to hospitals, more support for nurses and paramedics and the biggest increase to mental health support we have seen so more Victorians get the care they need.

Jobs for our Suburbs

At the heart of our economic recovery must be jobs creation.

Our Jobs Plan will create 400,000 new jobs by 2025 and I'm making sure the inner north benefits from these opportunities.

That includes targeted support for our local traders, our creative industries and our manufacturing sectors – as well as more TAFE and training places to give Victorians the skills they need to get into work.







Building Better Schools

I will keep working to deliver for our local schools.

The last 12 months have seen over \$45 million secured for school upgrades, on top of the \$25 million already delivered in 2019.

This means a new multipurpose hall for Bell Primary School, classroom upgrades at Croxton School, a new STEAM Centre at Thornbury High, and a complete transformation of Preston South Primary with a \$14.6 million upgrade.

Great schools are about creating opportunities for our young people – stay tuned as I continue to work with our schools to get them the facilities they need.

Innovative Learning

Schools are not just about buildings. They're about giving our kids the support they need to thrive.

We're expanding school breakfast programs, employing 4,000 tutors to help those who need an extra hand, funding new jobs coordinators and putting mental health practitioners in secondary schools.

We're also completely transforming and expanding support for students with disabilities and getting targeted support to students with autism, dyslexia and complex behaviours.

I am committed to making sure the inner north gets its fair share of these benefits.

Getting the most out of Kinder

28 local kinders are benefiting from over \$323,000 through our historic School Readiness funding, giving children specialised support such as speech and occupational therapists, language and literacy experts and child psychologists.

Two of our local kinders, Yappera and Batman, also received a combined \$257,000 to upgrade their facilities – creating better spaces for our littlest Victorians.

FREE IN 2021

We're making kinder free this year to ease the burden on families and help parents get back to work.

Every child enrolled in a funded kinder program will benefit. And families with children in unfunded programs will also get reduced fees. This will make a huge difference to families in Northcote.

A New Bell Precinct

Work is underway to transform Preston – removing a massive four level crossings at Oakover, Bell, Cramer and Murray roads. This incredible rail project has so many benefits for our community.

Growing Sport

I'm determined to grow the inner north into a destination precinct for community sport.

This year we opened four new netball courts at John Cain Memorial Park, secured funding for an upgrade of Corben Oval cricket ground, finished new changerooms for the Fitzroy Stars and we're kicking in \$2 million to complete an indoor high-ball stadium in Thornbury.

Over 40 local clubs accessed \$1,000 COVID support grants and statewide we're pumping over \$21 million into community sport vouchers to get 100,000 more kids involved.
